- Any child presenting symptoms relating to the items below will not be permitted into Mosaic Kids until the symptoms are gone for at least a 24 hrs period of time.
- Acute cold
- Fever
- Excessive sneezing & runny nose (yellow/green discharge)
- Excessive coughing
- Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Bleeding/wet diaper rash
- Sore throat
- Eye/Ear infections
- Unexplained skin rash
- Parasites (nits, lice, mites, ringworm, etc.)
